- Activities undertaken in collaboration with all participating/interested IOMC Organizations, coordinated by UNITAR

#### Activity 4.1 Development of promotional and training material

- ✓ Design and production of promotional material in all six UN languages to be used by IOMC Organizations at promotional events such as conferences, workshops and exhibitions.
- ✓ Promotional material will include flyers/brochures and memory sticks containing information for dissemination and posters for display. In addition, promotional information will be developed for, and disseminated through, the IOMC website.
- ✓ Educational material will include a standard PowerPoint presentation on the introduction of the Toolbox, a presentation on the tools included in the Toolbox, and two to three exercise scenarios for training, with a teachers' guide.

### **Activity 4.2 Promotion of the Toolbox**

- ✓ Events organized to promote the IOMC Toolbox at, or back-to-back to, 6 key international events, including:
  - (i) the World Congress on Occupational Safety and Health (2014)
  - (ii) a session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee to prepare a global legally binding instrument on mercury (2014)
  - (iii) four SAICM regional meetings (between 2013-2015)
  - (iv) a meeting of the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership (2014)
  - (v) The 4<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Chemicals Management (ICCM-4) (2015), and
  - (vi) at the Basel, Rotterdam, and Stockholm Conventions Conference of Parties (2015).
- ✓ Toolbox training and promotion sessions will be built into existing workshop and seminar programs organized by IOMC Organizations

#### **Activity 4.2 Promotion of Toolbox, cont.**

- ✓ Consideration of other events to promote the Toolbox, including PRTR Protocol Bureau meetings, UNECE meetings of Capacity Building Coordination, meetings of the Working Group of the Parties to the PRTR Protocol, meetings of the Compliance Committee of the PRTR Protocol, meetings of the Parties of the PRTR Protocol, meetings of the PRTR International Coordinating Group, OPCW meetings, meetings of subsidiary bodies of Conferences of the Parties (e.g. POPRC, Rotterdam CRC, etc.), or meetings of the GHS subcommittee.
- ✓ Materials will be updated as the Toolbox evolves, and a pool of exerts who know the Toolbox well and will help IOMC Organizations undertake a Toolbox side-event or Toolbox training session will be created and maintained

### **Activity 4.3 Training on the Toolbox**

- Organization of Toolkit training at events in existing training programs of IOMC Organizations
- This could include, for example:
  - ✓ National workshops on specific chemicals/wastes issues
  - ✓ Other regional or subregional meetings hosted by individually or jointly between one or more IOMC Organizations
  - ✓ Expert meetings or consultation meetings
