There is no option to intensifying agricultural production, which must be done in ways that protect and enhance the ecological services farmers depend on.

FAO supports countries in all aspects of sustainable production intensification (SPI). In addressing pest and pesticide management the approach taken is holistic: life cycle management: comprehensive adherence to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions, pursuance of the SAICM 2020 Goals and implementation of the International Code of Conduct on Pesticides Management.
