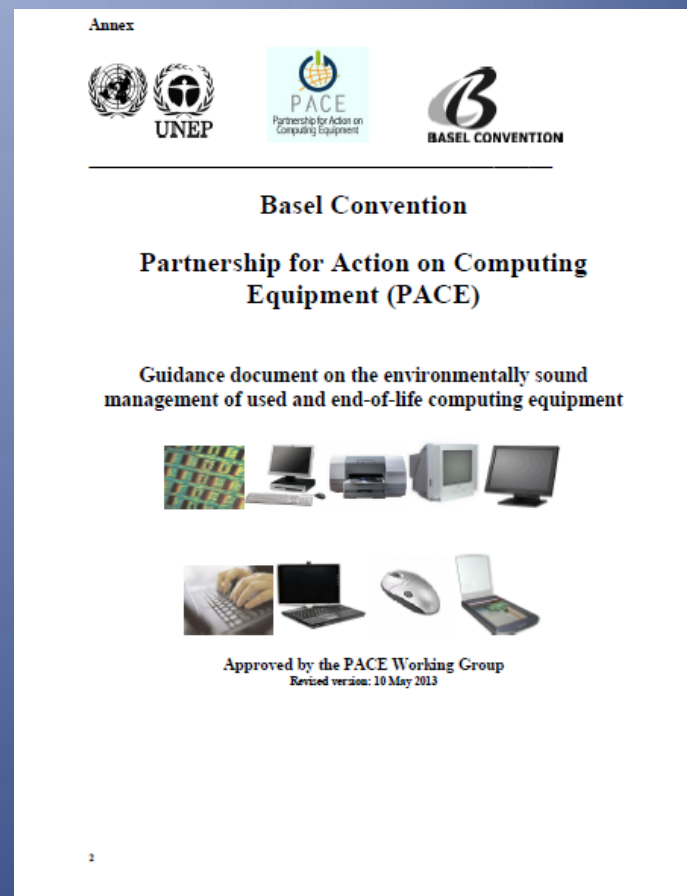

# PACE working principles

- Goal definition
- Involvement of partners in the set-up of the partnership, i.e. definition of Terms of Reference including mandate, scope and working principles
- All partners have equal status, rights and responsibilities
- Submission of outcome to the Conference of the Parties to the BC for final adoption



- Glossary of terms
- Report with ESM criteria recommendations
- Guidance document
- Guideline on Environmentally Sound Testing, Refurbishment and Repair of Used Computing Equipment
- Guideline on Environmentally Sound Material Recovery and Recycling of End-of-Life Computing Equipment
- Report on strategies, actions and incentives to promote environmentally sound management of used and end-of-life computing equipment
