


Preparations for the 2019 meetings of the conferences of the Parties to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions

29 April -10 May 2019, CICG, Geneva


Financial support and credentials

- **Financial assistance** for up to three delegates, as funds permit, for States that are developing countries or countries with economy in transition and Party to all three conventions (deadline: 23 January 2019; 15 February 2019 for third delegate)
- Financial support pledged by: Germany, Norway and Switzerland
- Original and copies of credentials in good order will be accepted, with the understanding that the original will be submitted as soon as possible
 - Credentials are to be issued by the Head of State or Government or by the Minister for Foreign Affairs
 - Submission to the Secretariat if possible no later than 24 hours after the opening of the meetings (by 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 30 April 2019)
 - Model for credentials available in all 6 UN languages
 - Credentials for all 3 meetings can be in one document



Rotterdam Convention COP-9 main issues

Compliance

- Draft text of procedures and institutional mechanisms on compliance
- Proposal to add a new annex VII to the Convention

Enhancing the effectiveness of the Rotterdam Convention

- Recommendations from intersessional working group to be considered at COP-9
- Consideration of proposals from African countries from COP-8 to amend Articles 16 and 22

Listing of chemicals in Annex III to the Convention

- «New» chemicals: acetochlor, hexabromocyclododecane, phorate
- «Old» chemicals: carbosulfan, chrysotile asbestos, fenthion formulations, paraquat formulations

Status of implementation of the Rotterdam Convention

- General issues related to the implementation of the Convention
- Proposals to increase the number of notifications of final regulatory action
- Exchanging information on exports and export notifications



Stockholm Convention COP-9 main issues

Listing of chemicals in Annex A, B or C

- Recommendation to list:
 - Dicofol in Annex A without specific exemptions
 - PFOA, its salts and PFOA-related compounds in Annex A with specific exemptions
- Proposals to amend Article 8 and Annex D of the Convention submitted by the Russian Federation

Reduce or eliminate release from intentional production and use

- DDT (evaluate the continued need)
- PCBs (review progress on elimination)
- PFOS, its salts and PFOS (POPRC recommendation to amend Annex B)

Compliance

For possible adoption based on the draft texts in the annex to decision SC-7/26

National Implementation Plans (NIPs)

 Electronic template for reporting information in NIPs; revised guidance on developing and updating NIPs

Effectiveness evaluation (EE) and Global monitoring plan (GMP)

- Consider adoption of a revised framework for EE
- Consider the draft updated GMP guidance

Other main issues on SC COP-9 agenda

 Reporting, toolkit and BAT & BEP, exemptions, measures to reduce or eliminate releases from wastes

Technical assistance – financial resources

- Technical assistance
- BC and SC regional centres
- Financial resources:
 - Implementation of integrated approach
 - SC financial mechanism

Enhancing cooperation and coordination among the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions

- International cooperation and coordination
- Clearing house mechanism for information exchange
- Mainstreaming gender
- Synergies in preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes
- From science to action

Budget and programmes of work

- 2 scenarios:
 - Zero nominal growth scenario
 - Executive Secretaries' scenario, 5% growth (2.5% annually)

Memorandums of Understanding between UNEP and the COPs (and FAO in the case of RC)

- Three convention-specific MoUs in front of the COPs for possible adoption
- Developed by the Secretariat in consultation with UNEP (and FAO for RC)
