BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND PROJECT JUSTIFICATION			
<p>The assessment of funding needed by developing country parties and parties with economies in transition to implement the Convention over the period 2018-2022 is a recurrent task that aims at enabling the Conference of the Parties to provide to the principal entity entrusted with the operation of the financial mechanism, at periodic intervals, assessments of the total funding, which consists of funding for baseline and agreed full incremental costs, needed by parties eligible for assistance from the financial mechanism to facilitate their effective implementation of the Convention.</p> <p>As part of this work, the Secretariat is requested to review the availability of financial resources additional to those provided through the Global Environment Facility and the ways and means of mobilizing and channeling those resources in support of the objectives of the Convention, as requested by the Conference of Plenipotentiaries of the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants in resolution 2. In order to support Parties in providing information to this effect, the Secretariat has been requested to develop, within available resources and on the basis of the most recent needs assessment, an online questionnaire to potential donors on the way in which they can support the Convention in relation to specific key areas identified in the needs assessment, including information related to accessing this support.</p>
