PURPOSE AND APPROACH:		
<p>The conferences of the parties at their ordinary meetings in 2013 decided to convene in 2015 back-to-back meetings of the ordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions (without a high-level segment or simultaneous extraordinary meetings) in Geneva that include joint sessions, where appropriate, on joint issues and that prioritize an agenda and schedule that focus on substantive matters related to implementation of the conventions and provide sufficient time for their consideration.</p> <p>This activity aims at facilitating the full and active participation of representatives of developing-country parties and of parties with economies in transition in the twelfth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention to improve the legitimacy of Convention decisions and encourage the implementation of the Convention at the local, national, regional and international levels. For instance, an important decision to be taken by the COP will be to establish the work programme and budget of the Convention for the biennium 2016-2017.</p>		
PROPOSED ACTIVITIES TO BE FUNDED:		
<p>1. Funding for travel, including air tickets and Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA), will be provided for thirteen days for up to 100 participants for the Basel Convention or a total of 300 eligible participants for the three conventions in Geneva, Switzerland, including one day without formal meetings, plus one day for pre-meetings (regional and bureaux meetings).</p>		
RESULTS TO BE ACHIEVED:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Balanced representation of developed and developing countries, as well as countries with economies in transition at the COP; • Effective participation in negotiations towards reaching agreements that are workable for all parties; • Improved legitimacy of decisions taken by the COP; • Strengthened implementation of the Convention at all levels; • Opportunities for participants to meet and consolidate their positions as regions; • Opportunities for developed and donor countries to discuss implementation issues with participants from developing countries and countries with economies in transition; • Opportunities for participants to participate in side-events.
